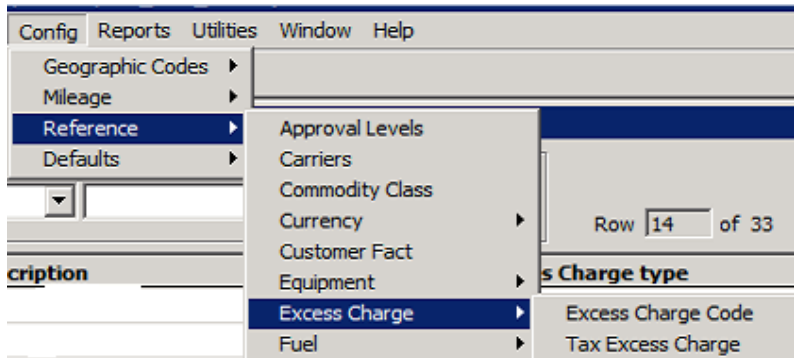


TAXES CALCULATED ON A PERCENTAGE OF FREIGHT PLUS ADDITIONAL CHARGES (FUEL, ACCESSORIALS, ETC.)



If an excess charge is a tax percentage that is calculated on more than just the freight, set the Excess Charge Type to **TAX**. Otherwise, leave it as **STANDARD**. Setting this to **TAX** will tell RateServer to calculate it based on freight and other non-accessorial charges such as fuel and switch charges. If additional accessorial charges need to be added into the tax calculation, these need to be identified on the Tax Excess Charge table.

Go to Tax Excess Codes and tell RateServer which additional charges to include in the tax calculation. For instance, here RateServer will include any cleaning charges and diversions in addition to the freight and fuel when calculating the GST tax.
