



**CLM Explanation

RAILTRAC imports and organizes CLMs (Car Location Movements) using trips to house CLM cycles based on customer defined car types. The primary source of CLM data in RAILTRAC is Railinc. CLM data from Railinc is comprised of TRAIN II data which comes from the railroads. This data is then matched to waybill data to apply the destination to the CLM.

CLMs are generated when an AEI (Automatic Equipment Identification) tag on a railcar passes an AEI reader. The reader sends a CLM message that RAILTRAC receives from Railinc, when authorized. CLMs can also be entered manually by authorized personnel.
