Overview

RAILTRAC® Advance Version 1.4 delivers targeted enhancements and bug fixes to improve system usability, performance, and reporting accuracy.

Enhancements

SYSTEM WIDE

- Standardized date/time input fields to exclude seconds and milliseconds from the front-end UI everywhere they existed, like Shipments, CLMs, Interface Validations.
- Customers now have the ability to imbed a Shipper BI dashboard on the homepage of RT Advance.

INTERFACE VALIDATIONS

- In Interface Validations, the trip that opens when View Previous Trip is clicked now features a Delete Trip button.
- Added Route Code field (from the import) to the Import Details section in Advance.
- Change name of the Interface Detail pill to Interface Validations Detail.

SHIPMENTS

- Renamed “Last Hot Comments” to “Last Hot List Comments” in RAILTRAC Hot List Grid
- Modified the Logic to ensure Is Comments field is properly displaying.
- Added Car Mech Fleet and Business Group to TEMPLATE: TRACE EMPTY TO ORIGIN
- Added Railroad ETAs to Available columns in the grid for customers who license this feature. Column names are RR Div Date Time and RR Div Update Road
- Rename grid column Is Trip Diverted to a clearer display name of Diversion Source
- The Consignee dropdown now disappears when the Consignee search button is clicked.

JEOPARDIZED SHIPMENTS

- Add to Hot List button now adds a Hot List that does not require a refresh to see in Jeopardized Shipments - Bad Orders
- Add Comment action button in Jeopardized Shipments/ Destination Difference
- Adjusted the default grid for Jeopardized Shipments - Off Route.

GPS

- Created Component for GPS Data to Show Sensor Information, Location History and Alerts
- Added the ability to link to a Specific Trip from GPS Data Screens

DIVERSIONS

- When users update a Return City on single or multiple trips, we are displaying a message “Changing a return city on a trip will not be reported as a diversion”.
- The Route Code dropdown now disappears when the Route Code search button is pressed in the Route Code header and the Route Code field.
- Users now have the ability to delete diversions. When a diversion is deleted, the previous trip is reset.
- Diversions are now only allowed on current shipments.
- Redesigned the Diversion screen for Multi Car diversions.

Resolutions

SHIPMENTS

- The Return City search grid is now sorted in alphabetical order by City/State

ROUTES

- Route Code Active Status is now properly saving.
- Route Code required fields now display correctly during route creation.

DIVERSIONS

- When a shop trip is diverted and the only CLM is a Q record, fixed an issue that was keeping the Current City and State from populating in the form.
- Resolved an issue where the shop form did not populate current product name or STCC when diversion was created.
- The shop form now populates the capacity of the railcar.
- The shop form now reflects the updated fleet or business group after diversion.
- Shop Forms now display the correct lease/rider information.
- Resolved an issue where the Shop form was not displaying shop name or contact information for shop locations.
- Resolved an issue where the Shop Form was appearing on the original trip during a diversion. The Shop form now only appears on the new trip as expected.
- Resolved an issue on version 1.4.1 where the Shop Forms were not editable after creation.
- Only one End of Life date field now appears in the shop form.
- Resolved an issue where the shipment type was changing on the Shop Form to default when updating the route code.
- If a shop or storage consignee is missing or has an incorrectly spelled destination city on their Customer Fact record and this used during a diversion, the application will now stop the user and advise the Destination City is not found for this customer.

- The shop form now pops up after a shop diversion and is made available after a shop trip is added.
- When a shop trip is manually added, the shop form now pops up when the trip is saved.
- Restyled the Dates section of the Shop Form for users in Dark Mode
- The consignee dropdown now disappears when the consignee search icon is clicked in Diversions.

CLMs

- Fixed an issue in the CLMs grid that was not removing No Bill CLM Events properly.

HOT LIST

- Resolved an issue where “Get Data Is In” received a filter error for more than sixteen records in the Hot List grid.

REPORTS/TEMPLATES

- Added missing field to the Transit Time - Trip Cycle - Detail report.
- The Ship Dates are now populated correctly in Specialty - Origin Performance and ETA Performance by Shipment
- The dates and times in the Transit Time by Route Segment - Detail report are in the correct time zone.
- Dates in the Transit Time - Trip Cycle - Detail report are now in the correct time zone.
- Fixed intermittent “Begin Date must be ≤ End Date” messaging when dates are edited before tabbing.
- Date format has been fixed in the Reports - Trip Comments report.
- All previously missing reports from Classic have been restored in Advance.
- Row counters have been added to all reports.

JEOPARDIZED SHIPMENTS

- Fixed an issue where the Clear No Bill CLM Events action in the ellipsis menu did not work.
- Resolved an issue where selecting Add New Trip from Jeopardized Shipments ellipsis menu does not open shipment detail correctly.
- The Current CLM is now displaying in the header for Jeopardized Shipments
- Fixed an error in Jeopardized Shipments where users were unable to query more than 16 Car ID's using Get Data
- Corrected Never Shipped grid record mismatch between Advance and Hybrid

INTERFACE VALIDATIONS

- For single Interface Validations, the Add Imports, Re-Process, and Update Interface Validations buttons now correctly switch between active and read-only states based on the actions taken to process Interface Validations
- Fixed an issue with changes saving when multiple interface validations are updated.
- When multiple Interface Validations are selected, items in common and not in common are now displayed correctly.
- Resolved an issue where the Ship Date Time in the Interface Validation grid does not match the (correct) Ship Date Time in detail.
- Fixed an issue where the Update Interface Validations button was not functioning.
- Users are now able to update multiple Interface Validations' Trip Ref fields by performing one multi-update.
